# What is H.E.A.L.?

## Helping Explore Accountable Lifestyles

- ◆ Intensive 39-session batterers intervention program for men
- ◆ Group sessions available on Wednesdays from 5:30-7:00 p.m. and Sundays from 12:00-1:30 p.m. at BASES in Charlevoix
- ◆ The program is designed to intervene in the lives of men who batter women and encourage accountability for the safety and respect of everyone.
- ◆ BASES counselors will facilitate the group, while participants help to hold one another accountable
- ◆ Self-referrals to this program are welcomed as well
- ◆ Many participants are involved in counseling to address substance use disorders as well
- ◆ The #1 reason people do not complete the program is ongoing substance abuse issues
- ◆ Costs: \$25.00 workbook, \$25.00 per session, costs are not covered by third party sources



## Program Mission

To hold those who perpetrate domestic abuse and violence accountable for their actions. We do this by providing an educational environment where men are helped to identify and acknowledge their use of violence or control and are offered an opportunity to explore personal accountability and options so they can implement changes in their lives.

## Program Policy

BASES is committed to the safety of victims and to holding batterers accountable for their behavior. Releases to partners/victims are optional. Any documentation of communication with a partner is kept separate from the program participant's file. Victims/partners will be given referrals to shelters or other appropriate survivor services.

## Other Services

- ◆ Substance use disorder evaluations for adults and adolescents
- ◆ Individual outpatient counseling for adults and adolescents
- ◆ Group outpatient counseling for adults and adolescents
- ◆ Drug / breathalyzer testing for courts, employers, families and self
- ◆ Alcohol / Drug education classes for first-time offenders
- ◆ Secretary of State Driver's License Appeal Division (DLAD) substance use disorder evaluations
- ◆ Transportation assistance for counseling clients if you live in Charlevoix County
- ◆ Community presentations upon request
- ◆ Free consultation services to identify available options
- ◆ Referral services
- ◆ Assistance with Medicaid
